

□ What is a "leaked" video?	
A <i>leaked video</i> is any private, intimate, or personal recording shared online without the knowledge or agreement of the person in it. It can happen in many ways:	
 ■ Hacking – stolen from phones, clouds, or accounts 	
● □ Betrayal of trust – when someone close shares something private	
Secret or unauthorized recording	
● □ Screenshots or re-uploads of private content	
☐ These are not just "clips" or "content." They are serious violations of privacy .	
☐ The Real-World Cost of a Leak	
When we see something trending online, it's easy to forget the human being on the other side of the screen. Sharing a leaked video might feel harmless \Box , but the damage it causes can be devastating:	
● □ Emotional trauma, anxiety, and lasting psychological harm	
□ Damage to career, family relationships, and reputation	
● ☐ Harassment, bullying, blackmail, or even extortion	

Long-term shame and public judgment
Behind every view, comment, or share is another cut into someone's dignity.
□ Stop and Think Before You Share
Next time you stumble upon a "viral" or "leaked" clip, pause for a moment. Ask yourself \square :
 Did this person choose to share this publicly? □
• Is it ethical for me to watch, react, or pass it along? $\Box \circlearrowleft \Box$
$ullet$ Would I want the most private moment of my life broadcast for strangers? \Box
If your answer is "no" $\ \square$, the choice is clear: close the tab, don't encourage, don't engage.
 □ ♂ □ What You Can Do Instead We are all shaping online culture together □. Every click, every comment adds to the system. Instead of fueling exploitation, here's how you can help: □ Don't share, like, or comment on leaked videos □ Report the content □ and the platform hosting it □ Call out harmful behavior when you see it □ □ Show empathy □ to those affected rather than judgment
□ Spread awareness about consent and digital safety □ ■ Privacy is a Right, Not a Luxury
Celebrity, scandal, or public curiosity do not erase someone's right to dignity □. Every single person — famous or not — deserves control over their: □ Image □ □ Body □ □ Voice □

It's time to stop treating leaked videos as gossip or entertainment. They are violations, plain and simple.
