How to book the cheapest lufthansa airlines one-way international flight?

Use Lufthansa's Own Cheap-Fare Tools

- Lufthansa's "best-price search" shows the lowest fares over a calendar of the coming months for a chosen origin-destination pair, best when dates are flexible.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- Standard flight search also gives a view of adjacent days, providing flexibility to spot cheaper fares on one-way options a day or two earlier or later.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))

The internal tools thus allow you to first set your expectations of what Lufthansa itself considers to be the lowest available fares on its route before carrying out other comparisons.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))

Choose the Right Fare Type (Economy Light)

- Within Europe, as well as on many international routes, Economy Light is Lufthansa's lowest fare with carry-on luggage; it is "the basic fare at the most affordable price" and it is great if you are carrying a hand bag only and do not intend to change the ticket.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- Light fares:
- Are usually non-refundable and quite often non-changeable, or are only changeable/rebookable with exorbitant fees and difference in fare.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- Do not include checked baggage and require additional charges for seat selection; however, you might book it later if need be.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))

As far as simple one-way pricing is concerned, Economy Light has almost always been the cheapest option available under the Lufthansa banner, provided you can stick to the rules.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))

Time Your Purchase And Your Travel

- Independent fare guides and blogs agree that Lufthansa one-way prices drop when you're in off-peak seasons: late January to early March and September to early December, giving school holidays and peak summer a miss.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- Booking at least 6–10 weeks in advance can be referred to as the sweet spot, especially in the economy cabin, although for ultra-peak dates (Christmas, August in Europe), you need to buy even earlier.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- A lot of studies show that fares on midweek departures, either on Tuesday or Wednesday, were cheaper, and also when booking avoids weekend pricing peaks, although this does not hold strictly in every case.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))

A combination of off-peak seasons, midweek flights, and a 6-10 week booking window would certainly make a huge difference to Lufthansa one-way pricing.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))

Use Comparison Sites And Alerts

- Meta-search engines for flights such as Skyscanner accumulate the fares and show the cheapest days in a month to fly Lufthansa on a selected route.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA)) In this context, Skyscanner mentions that Lufthansa fares tend to be the lowest on some routes in January, when demand is the weakest.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- Fare tips in the blogs indicate:
- Using flexible date searches for the entire month to locate the very cheapest outbound day.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- Setting price alerts, so you will know when the price of a one-way ticket drops and can book it at a low level.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))

These tools complement Lufthansa's own best-price searches and sometimes highlight days when partner sites or markets sell the same Lufthansa one-way seat cheaper.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))

Control Extras To Keep The "Cheap" Fare Cheap

- Economy Light -- adding a checked bag or changing seat assignments could go a long way toward negating the savings; Lufthansa charges for standard seats and extra legroom, with long-haul seat fees reaching as high as EUR 90-100 (USD 115), depending on the route.(+ 1 833 | 49 319 | 4940 (USA OTA))
- Current cost tables show that rebooking a US-origin Economy Light fare can take away about USD 199 in addition to fare difference, so if your plans are uncertain, a slightly more flexible fare might cost you much less in the end than a very rigid Light ticket that you later change.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))

For the real one-way costing, try to travel with cabin baggage only, forgo paid selection of a seat, and select flights that you can be very sure will not need changes.(+ 1 833 | 4940 (USA OTA))
