

Does Latam include a carry-on?

Yes, LATAM includes a personal item (fits under the seat) with all fares, but a larger carry-on bag for the overhead bin depends on your ticket type: it's included with most fares (Light, Full, Standard, Premium), but not with the Basic fare, where you must buy it separately, especially on domestic flights. Carry-on size is generally 55x35x25 cm (21.7x13.8x9.8 in), with weight limits varying by cabin (e.g., 12kg Economy, 16kg Premium).

Latam Airlines includes a carry-on allowance for all passengers, but the size, weight, and number of bags permitted may vary depending on the fare type and route. Passengers are generally allowed to bring one carry-on bag and one personal item, such as a handbag, laptop bag, or small backpack.
